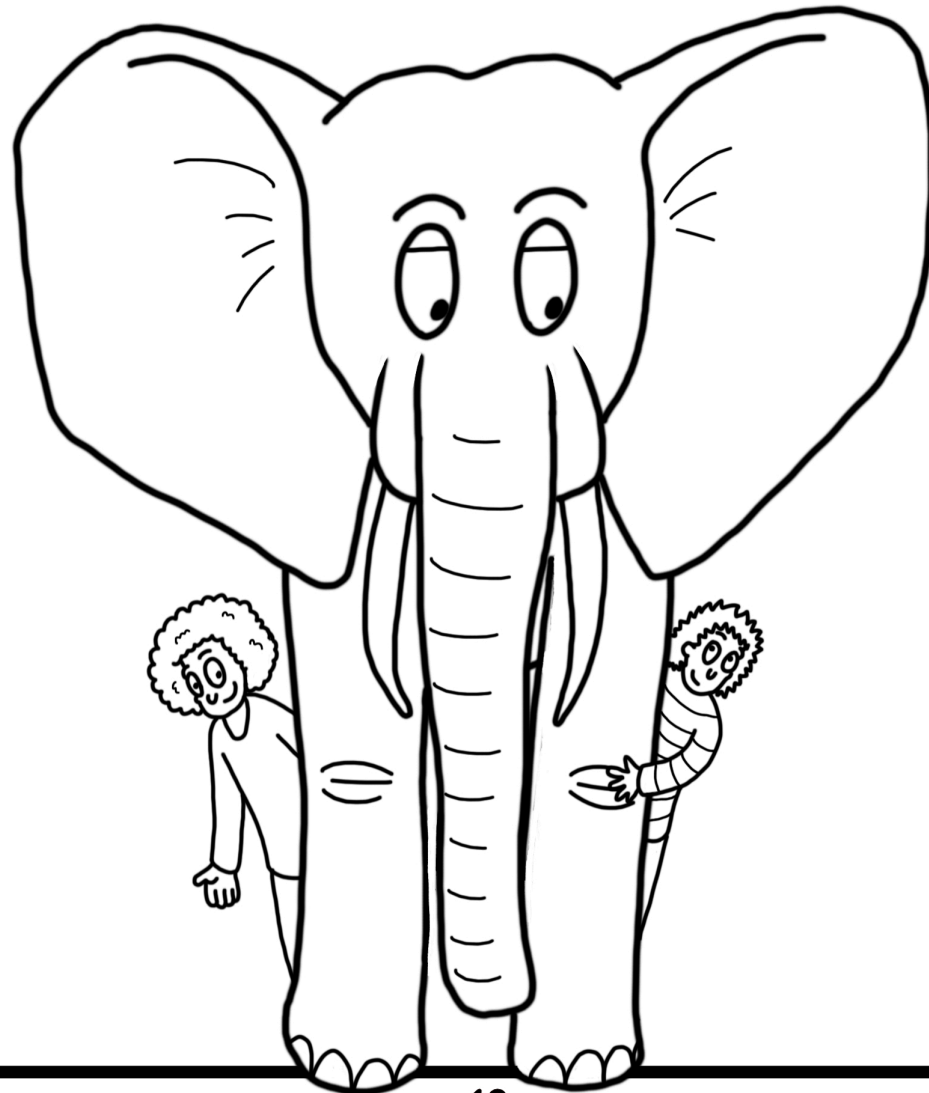
When I go outside,

to squeeze through between us.



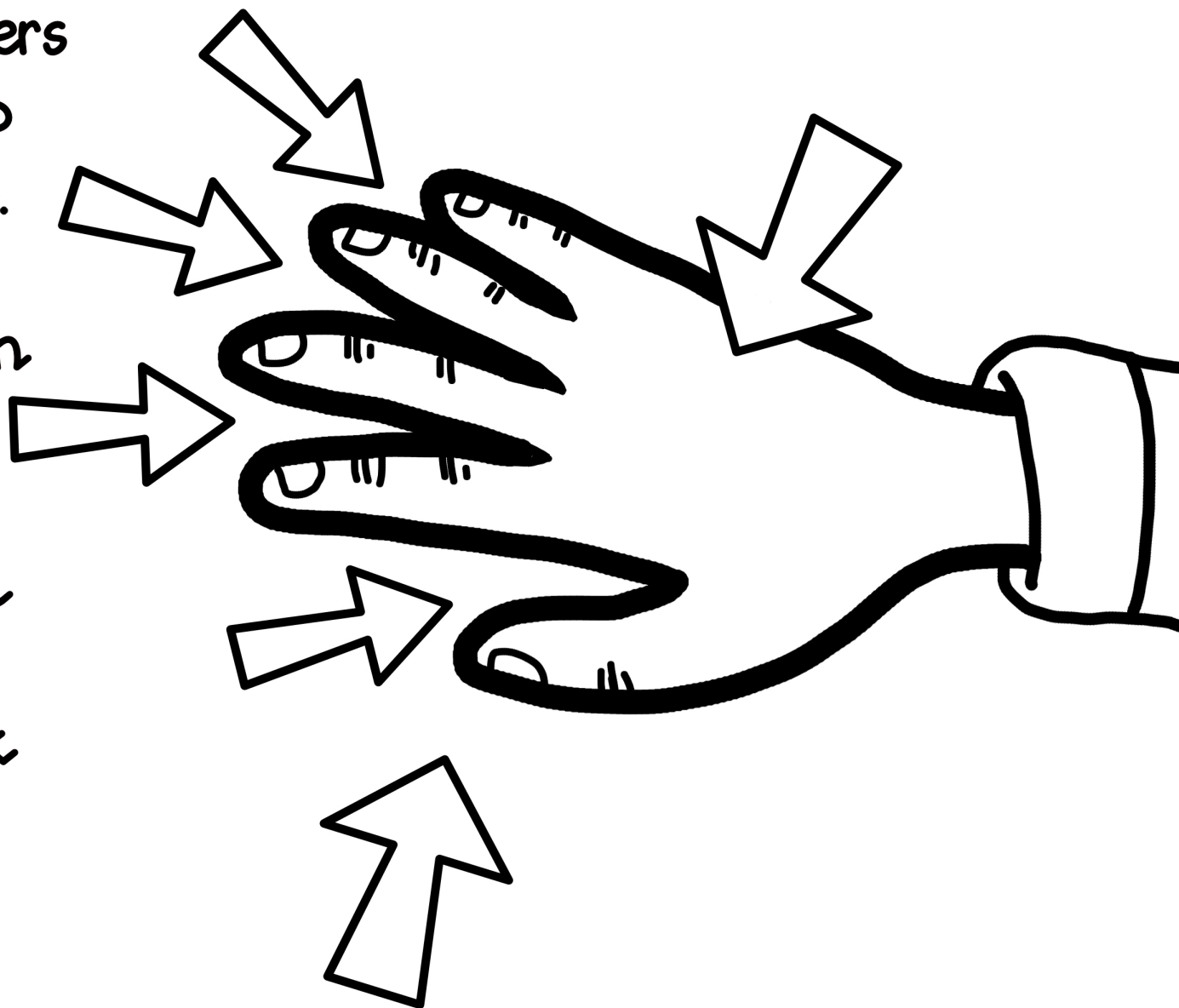
When I come back inside,

a lot.

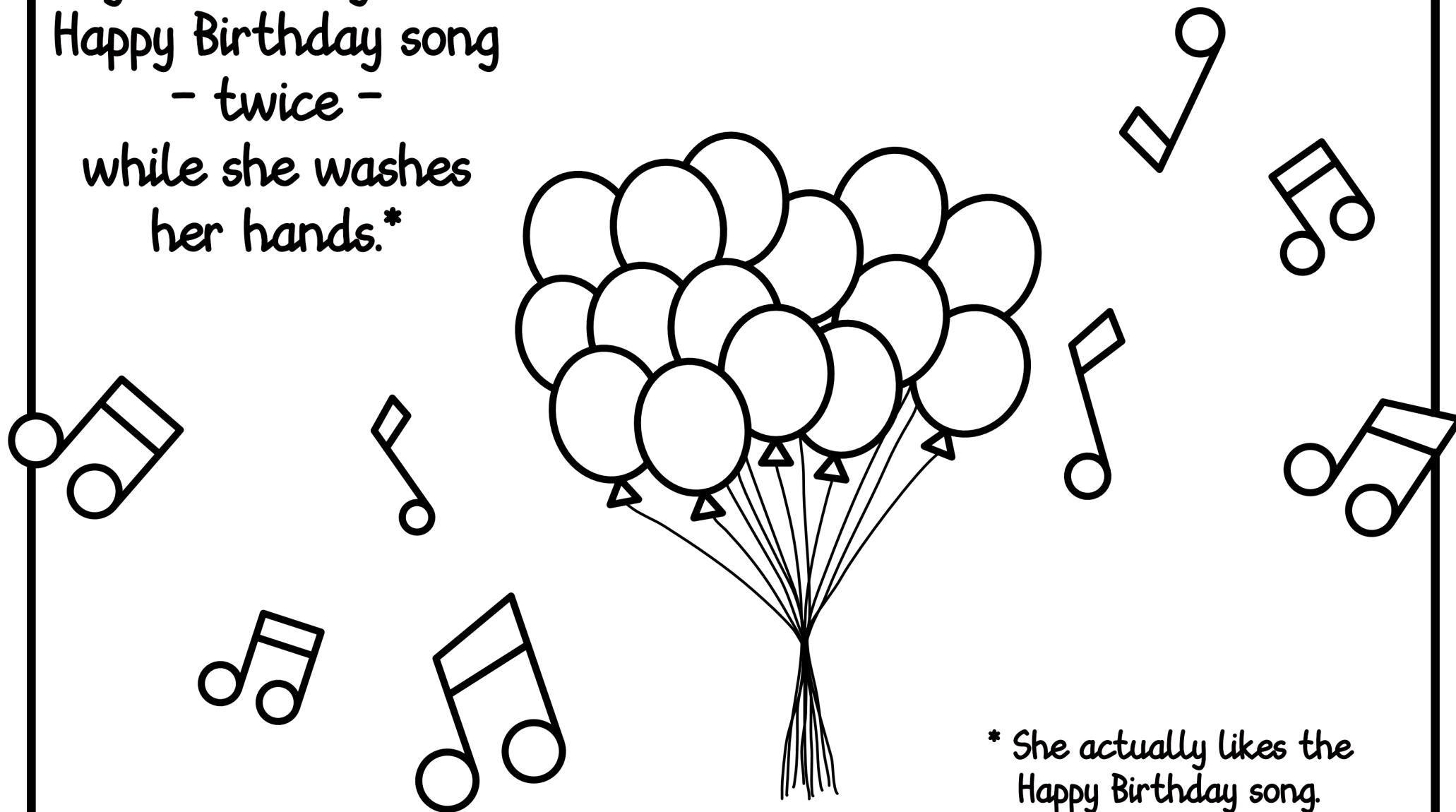


I have four fingers

her hands.*

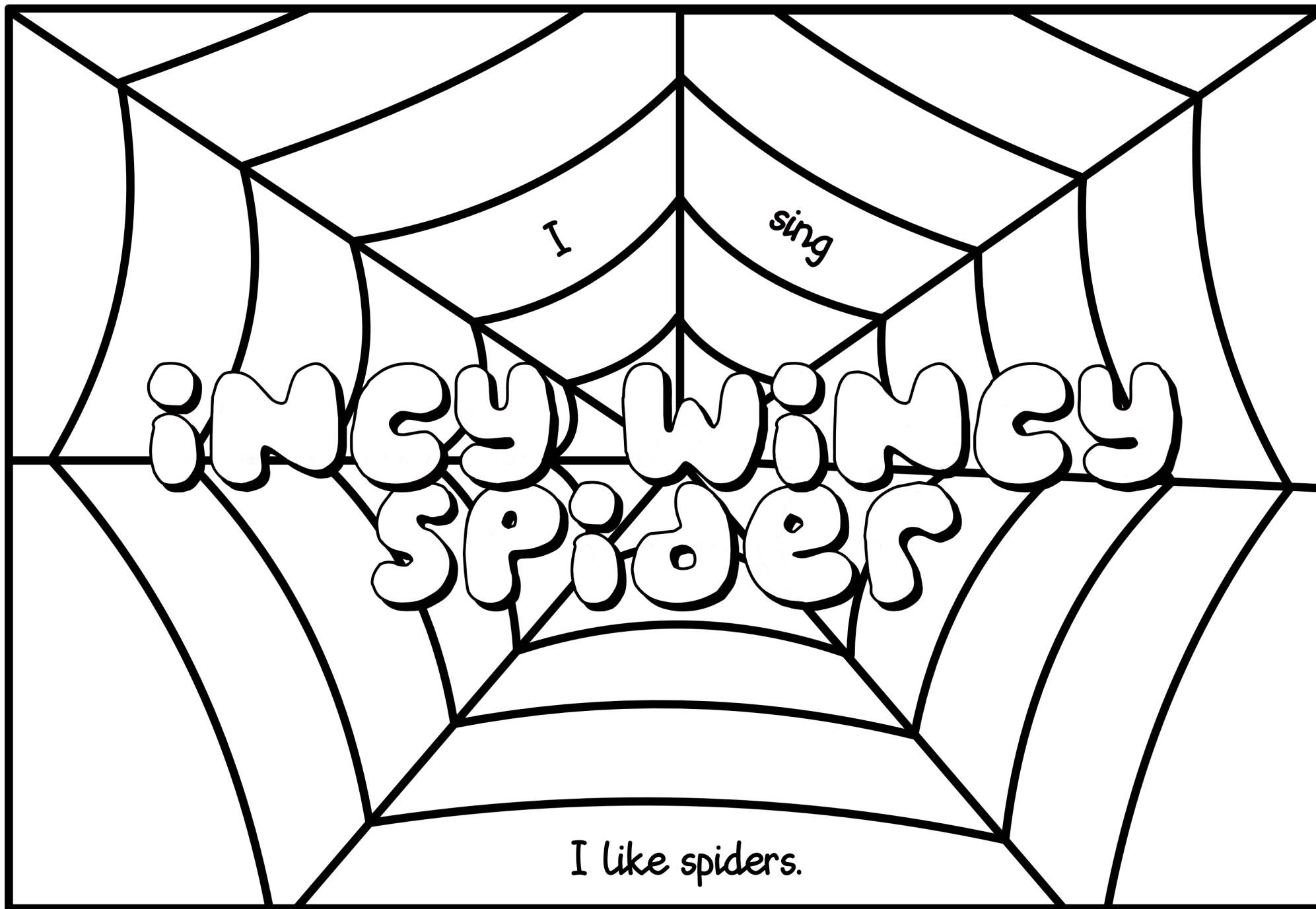

EEEEK!

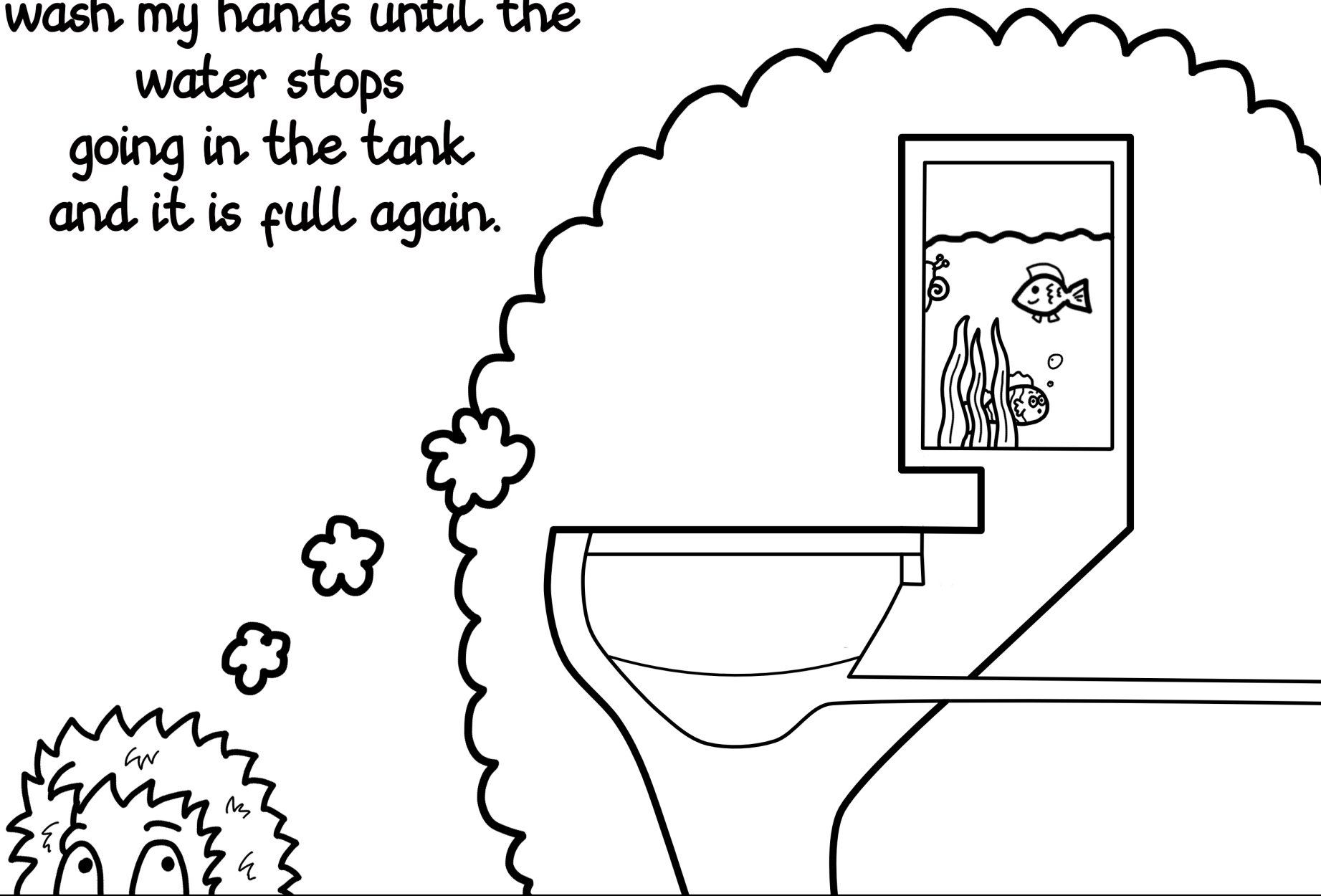
I make sure

is clean.



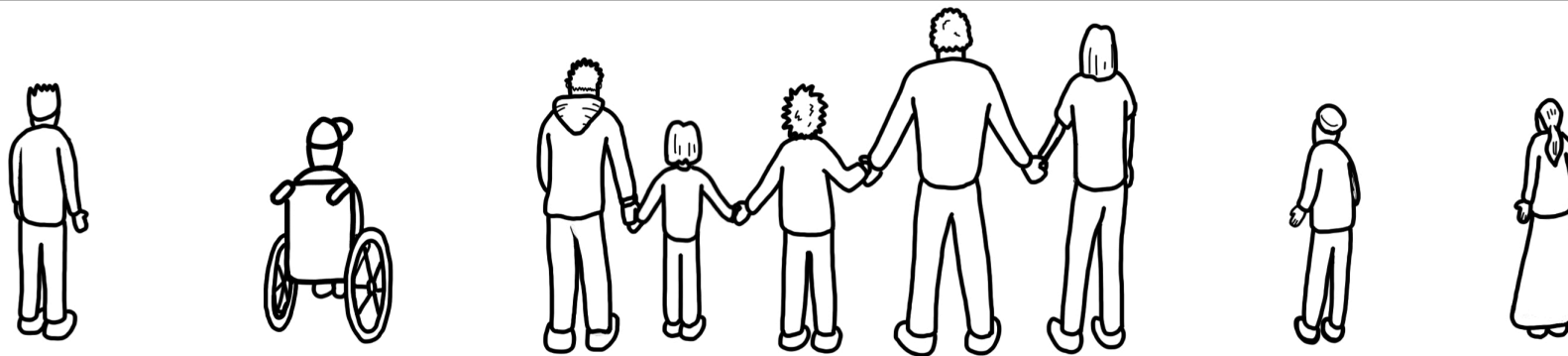
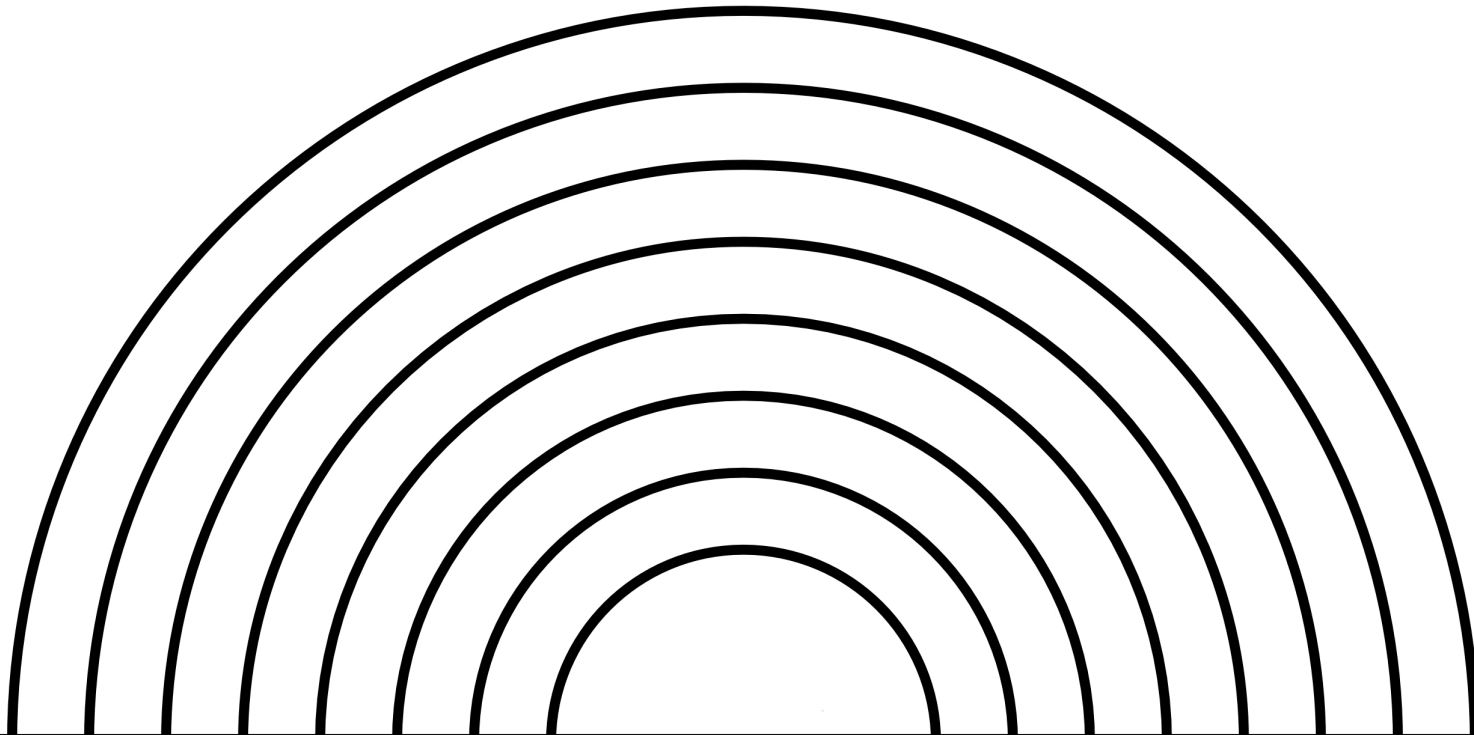
My Dad and I timed the toilet tank filling.
